Conference/Workshop Grant for PhD Students

The School of Public Policy supports our PhD students to present academic papers at reputable conferences, workshops, seminars.

This grant is awarded as stipulated below.

1. All PhD students at the School are eligible for this grant.

2. Terms and Conditions:

The grant covers travel expenses, accommodation, visa fees, travel, and health insurance for the duration of the travel, registration fees and allowance for a total of not more than 30,000 Thai Baht per student for his/her entire duration as a PhD student.

The dates and duration of travel must align with the conference/workshop/seminar. Allowance and accommodation are only for the duration of the conference/workshop/seminar.

PhD students who are receiving other grants or scholarships covering the expenses for attending and presentation at conferences must declare and provide details at the time of application for this grant. This grant can be used to supplement other grants and scholarships.

3. Conditions of the Grant:

- 1) The student must provide an acceptance letter from the conference.
- 2) The presentation can be in the form of an oral presentation or poster presentation.

- 3) The student must be the first author. Additional authors are permitted.
 - 4) The student must indicate affiliation with Chiang Mai University School of Public Policy.
 - 5) The student must seek reimbursement with appropriate receipts. This shall be completed in the same budget year.
4. Application process:
- Contact our Degree Program officer at spp@cmu.ac.th for the application form. The student must seek approval from his/her main adviser before submitting to the School for final approval. Approvals can be done via email or hardcopy.
